Shoayb Khattab

The best architecture deserves the finest visuals.

Shoayb Khattab is an international artist with an award-winning portfolio, working across architecture, photography, and film. Based between the **UAE** and **KSA**, his work over the past decade has focused on the structures and built landscapes shaping the region today.

Originally an architect, he has since produced some of the finest photography of the region's most iconic landmarks, recognized with the industry's top architecture photography awards and published across the world's leading design publications.

Shoayb Khattab is a multidisciplinary visual artist working across architecture, photography, and film. Born and raised in the Arab world, he studied architecture before committing himself fully to photography and film, building a practice shaped by structure, observation, and a personal way of seeing.

Over more than a decade, he has built an international body of work spanning iconic towers, cultural institutions, luxury hospitality, and branded environments. His commissions have taken him across the Middle East, Europe, and beyond, working with some of the most renowned architecture firms, cultural institutions, and high-end clients across the globe. Each project follows the same disciplined approach: study the architecture, understand the brief, and wait for the light.

His work has earned more than 60 international honours, including the Architizer+ Photographer of the Year, the Architecture Masterprize Architectural Photographer of the Year, the Créateurs Design Awards, and recognition among the world's top 100 architectural photographers by the Loop Design Award. He has also been named to the Visionary 100, Architizer's curated selection recognising influential studios and creators shaping the future of architecture. He has been featured in Dezeen, Architectural Digest, ArchDaily, Wallpaper*, Vogue, and Designboom, among others.

He is selective in the projects he takes on, choosing to work where there is genuine creative ambition and a clear understanding of what the images are meant to carry.

Alongside his practice, he remains involved in the wider architectural field through judging and professional affiliations. He has served as a judge for the Architecture Hunter Awards, one of the leading platforms in the field, and is a member of the Créateurs Design Awards.

Beyond photography, Shoayb also directs architectural films. His film work looks at architecture through movement, light, atmosphere, and time. It has screened at international festivals and received recognition for cinematography. He also lectures and leads workshops on architectural photography, sharing his methodology with the next generation of visual practitioners.

An architect by training and instinct. Every frame is shaped by proportion, material, interaction of light, human presence, and the intent behind the design. The difference lies in understanding the architecture, not simply pointing a camera at it.

EQUIPMENT MOST PHOTOGRAPHERS WILL NEVER OWN

Medium format cameras capable of producing 100+ megapixel files, built for billboard scale reproduction and exhibition-worthy fine art print. The difference is visible in the depth of detail, tonal range, and the clarity retained at scale.

PROVEN AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL

More than sixty international awards from leading architecture and design platforms, alongside commissions with Foster + Partners, Bjarke Ingels Group, and other globally established firms. The work has been tested at the highest level and recognized accordingly.

POSITIONED INSIDE THE INDUSTRY

As head of studio at Flint Studio, the production arm of Flint Culture, a leading PR and communications agency, the work moves with the support of established media relationships, editorial access, and communications infrastructure that most photographers simply do not have.

A PARTNER, NOT A VENDOR

Not a service provider completing a brief. A partner invested in the outcome. Every project is approached as a problem to solve, asking what this building needs to look like in the world, and what it takes to get it there.

NOT EVERY PROJECT NEEDS THIS

Some projects need any photographer. The best architecture needs the best one. This practice is built around commissions with genuine creative ambition and lasting value, prioritizing legacy and creative merit over volume of bookings. If a project doesn't call for that level of craft, that's a fine outcome too.

FINE ART REALISM, NOT A RENDER

Post-processing grounded in an artistic vision that elevates without distorting. A real image in a true fine art realistic style, not an AI-polished render, not an over-processed composite. The architecture is the subject. The edit serves it.

PHOTOGRAPHY, FILM, AND THE FULL PICTURE

Director and studio founder with experience across both photography and film. Every commission is approached thinking about how the images will be used, where they will appear, and what value they need to deliver, not just what they look like on the day.

WORK THAT REACHES AWARD STAGES

The goal is not images in a folder. Award-winning work is work that gets submitted, recognized, and seen on the stages of the world's most distinguished architecture and design awards. That visibility benefits the architect, the developer, and the project long after delivery.

THE STRONGEST RETURN, NOT THE LOWEST RATE

Not the cheapest option. The option with the most to show for it, fifteen-plus years of specialized experience, world-class equipment, and a track record alongside the industry's leading names. The value is in never having to look further.

How I work.

—

PRE-PRODUCTION

Every project begins with a conversation, understanding the architecture, the brief, and what the image must communicate. I study drawings, visit the site, and plan around light conditions before a single frame is made.

ON SITE

I work with a small, focused team. Minimal footprint. No unnecessary disruption. Methodical and patient. Sometimes a single frame requires hours of waiting for the right light.

POST-PRODUCTION

Each image is processed in-house. The edit is restrained and true to the scene. Final images delivered in multiple formats for print, digital, and social.

THE BRIEF

Commissioned by Boobrook to photograph Noir Matière, a residential penthouse interior at Lana Residences, Dorchester Collection, Business Bay, Dubai. Architecture by Foster + Partners, interior by Boobrook. The brief called for photography that reflected their design language: reduction, material presence, and the precise use of light and darkness.

THE APPROACH

The shoot relied entirely on natural light. Each frame was planned around specific moments of day where light revealed the textures of polished concrete, blackened oak, oxidised steel, and deep-toned stone. Sunset against that material palette created a depth impossible to replicate artificially.

THE RESULT

Delivered interior photography, time-lapse film, and an architect and designer interview. Won **Best Project Photography** at the Créateurs Design Awards, Paris, ceremony held at Shangri-La Hotel. Published in eArchitect, Architecture List, Architonic, Archino, and FRAME. Shortlisted for the FRAME Award.
